Fall River Residents

Important Information About Pay-As-You-Throw Trash Collection

Effective August 4, 2014, all residents who participate in curbside garbage disposal must purchase official City of Fall River bags for their trash.

For Trash Disposal: Place the purple trash bag into the green cart for trash collection. Note: The purple bags are for solid waste only and not recyclable items.

For Recycling Disposal: Place all recyclable materials loosely in the blue recycling cart for collection (mix all of your recyclables together into the same recycling cart). Please see reverse side for list of materials that can and cannot be recycled.

For your convenience, bags are available in three sizes and at the following prices (no sales tax will be applied):

- Mini 8 gallon (\$6.00 per sleeve of 8 bags)
- Small 15 gallon (\$10.00 per sleeve of 8 bags)
- Large 30 gallon (\$10.00 per sleeve of 5 bags)
